### TROPARIA

#### Resurrection (Tone 8)

Thou didst descend from on high O Merciful One! Thou didst accept the three-day burial to free us from our sufferings! O Lord, our Life and Resurrection: glory to Thee!

#### Transfiguration (Tone 7)

Thou wast transfigured upon the mountain, O Christ our God, showing Thy glory to Thy disciples as far as they were able to bear it. At the intercessions of the Theotokos, make Thine everlasting light shine forth also upon us sinners. O Giver of light, glory to Thee.

#### St. Herman (Tone 4)

O blessed Father Herman of Alaska, North Star of Christ's Holy Church! The light of thy holy life and great deeds guide us who follow the Orthodox way. Together we lift high the Holy Cross thou didst plant firmly in America. Let all behold and glorify Jesus Christ, singing His holy Resurrection.

### KONTAKIA

#### Resurrection (Tone 8)

By rising from the tomb, Thou didst raise the dead and resurrect Adam. Eve exults in Thy Resurrection, and the world celebrates Thy Rising from the dead, O greatly Merciful One! *Glory...*

#### Transfiguration (Tone 7)

On the mountain Thou wast transfigured, and Thy disciples beheld Thy glory, O Christ our God, as far as they were able so to do: that when they saw Thee crucified, they might know that Thy suffering was voluntary, and might proclaim unto the world that Thou art truly the Brightness of the Father.

Pray and make your vows before the Lord our God.

#### St. Herman (Tone 7)

Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His saints.

### HYMN TO THE THEOTOKOS

#### Instead of "It Is Truly Meet..." we sing:

Magnify, O my soul, the Lord who was transfigured on Mount Tabor! Thy birthgiving was incorruptible. God came in the flesh from thy womb and appeared on earth and dwelt among men. Therefore, we magnify thee, O Theotokos!
