TROPARIA

Resurrection (Tone 7)

By Thy Cross, Thou didst destroy death! To the thief, Thou didst open paradise! For the myrrhbearers, Thou didst change weeping into joy! And Thou didst command Thy disciples, O Christ God, to proclaim that Thou art risen, granting the world great mercy.

Three Hierarchs (Tone 1)

Let us who love their words come together with hymns, and honor the three great torchbearers of the triune Godhead: Basil the Great, Gregory the Theologian and John Chrysostom! These men have enlightened the world with the rays of their divine doctrines. They are sweetly flowing rivers of wisdom, and have filled all creation with springs of heavenly knowledge. They ceaselessly intercede for us before the Holy Trinity.

Three Hierarchs (Tone 4)

As sharers of the Apostles' life and character and teachers of the universe, intercede with the Master of all to grant peace to the world, and great mercy to our souls!
