LENTEN DRIVE: COMMONFOOD

The beneficiary of this year's Lenten fundraising drive is "CommonFood," a local 100% volunteer non-profit whose mission is to resource underserved and under-employed elderly, single-parent families, and low-income families in western Centre County and neighboring areas with nutritious food on a monthly basis.

Centre County currently has a food insecurity rate of 10.1%. Currently CommonFood is serving 21 communities surrounding State College including Tyrone, Bellefonte, Port Matilda, Julian and many of the small towns on the edges. As inflation is on the rise, CommonFood is expecting that the number of families they serve will increase in the coming months.

More information about CommonFood will be available in the coming weeks, and representatives from CommonFood will visiting our parish after the liturgy on Sunday, 3/27 to give a presentation. Please plan to stay and listen!
