TROPARION

Pentecost (Tone 8)

Blessed art Thou, O Christ our God, Who hast revealed the fishermen as most wise by sending down upon them the Holy Spirit; through them Thou didst draw the world into Thy net. O Lover of Man, glory to Thee! *Glory...*

KONTAKION

Pentecost (Tone 8)

When the Most High came down and confused the tongues, He divided the nations; but when He distributed the tongues of fire, He called all to unity. Therefore, with one voice we glorify the all-holy Spirit! *Now and ever...*

HYMN OF VENERATION

Instead of "Holy God...", we sing:

As many as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

PROKEIMENON

Pentecostarion (Tone 8)
