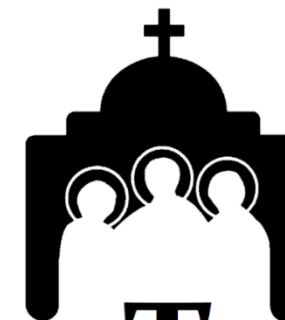

TROPARIA

Resurrection (Tone 3)

Let the heavens rejoice! Let the earth be glad! For the Lord has shown strength with His arm! He has trampled down death by death! He has become the first born of the dead! He has delivered us from the depths of hell, and has granted to the world great mercy.

Venerable Anthony (Tone 4)

Having left the turmoil of the world, thou didst renounce the world to follow Christ in accordance with the Gospel. Living a life equal to the angels, thou didst reach the quiet haven of the Holy Mountain of Athos. With the blessing of the Athonite fathers, thou didst come to the hills of Kiev, where thou didst labor with love and didst illumine thy homeland. There thou didst lead a multitude of monastics to Christ showing them the path that leads to the Kingdom of Heaven. Venerable Anthony, pray to Him that our souls may be saved!

HYMN TO THE THEOTOKOS

Venerable Anthony (Tone 8)
