## TODAY'S HYMNS

### TROPARIA

#### Resurrection (Tone 8)

Thou didst descend from on high O Merciful One! Thou didst accept the three day burial to free us from our sufferings! O Lord, our Life and Resurrection: glory to Thee!

#### St. Tikhon (Tone 1)

Chosen by God in a turbulent time, thou hast glorified God in complete holiness, and attained greatness through humility, showing forth the power of God through simplicity and piety. Thou didst lay down thy life for the Church and her people, O holy Confessor and Patriarch, Father Tikhon. Pray to Christ God with Whom thou wast also crucified, that He may save our souls!

### KONTAKIA

#### Resurrection (Tone 8)

By rising from the tomb, Thou didst raise the dead and resurrect Adam. Eve exults in Thy Resurrection, and the world celebrates Thy Rising from the dead, O greatly Merciful One! *Glory...*

#### St. Tikhon (Tone 2)

A gentle manner adorned thee: thou didst show kindness and compassion to those who repented; thou wast firm and unbending in confessing the Orthodox Faith, and zealous in loving the Lord. O holy Hierarch of Christ and Confessor Tikhon, pray for us that we may not be separated from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus, our Lord! *Now and ever...*
