TODAY'S HYMNS

TROPARIA

Resurrection (Tone 5)

Let us, the faithful, praise and worship the Word, co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit, born for our salvation from the Virgin; for He willed to be lifted up on the Cross in the flesh, to endure death, and to raise the dead by His glorious Resurrection.

Theophany (Tone 1)

When Thou, O Lord, wast baptized in the Jordan, the worship of the Trinity was made manifest. For the voice of the Father bore witness unto Thee, calling Thee the beloved Son, and the Spirit in the form of a dove confirmed His word as sure and steadfast. O Christ our God who hast appeared and enlightened the world, glory to Thee.

Martyrs (Tone 2)

O blessed Passion-bearers of the Lord, ye preached the Orthodox Faith of Christ with boldness, and at the tribunal denounced the false doctrines of the enemy; wherefore, ye were cast into the depths of the river, O Saints. Your souls now dwell in Heaven's mansions; ye stand with the Saints before the Throne of God, the King of all. Pray to Him for all Orthodox Christians, who cherish your hon'able struggles.

KONTAKIA

Resurrection (Tone 5)

Thou didst descend into hell, O my Savior, shattering its gates as almighty; resurrecting the dead as Creator and destroying the sting of death, Thou hadst delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of Man, and we all cry to Thee O Lord, save us! *Glory...*

Martyrs (Tone 4)

With hymns let us honor Christ's martyrs who suffered for the true Faith courageously and utterly vanquished the pride of the enemy. Illumined by the grace of the Undivided Trinity, O glorious ones who suffered with hieromartyr Isidore, ye shine forth like stars amid the whole world. Pray ye now to Christ unceasingly, and defend us from the attacks of our enemies, O constant intercessors for our souls. *Now and ever...*

Theophany (Tone 4)

Today Thou hast shown forth to the world, O Lord, and the light of Thy countenance has been marked on us. Knowing Thee, we sing Thy praises. Thou hast come and revealed Thyself, O unapproachable Light.

PROKEIMENA

Sunday After Theophany (Tone 1)

Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us as we have set our hope on Thee.

Martyrs (Tone 1)

The righteous cried and the Lord heard them.

HYMN TO THE THEOTOKOS

Instead of "It Is Truly Meet..." we sing:

Magnify, O my soul, the most pure Virgin Theotokos, more hon'able than the heavenly hosts! No tongue knows how to praise thee worthily, O Theotokos; even angels are overcome with awe praising thee. But since thou art good, accept our faith; for thou knowest our love inspired by God. Thou art the defender of Christians and we magnify thee.
