TROPARIA

Resurrection (Tone 1)

When the stone had been sealed by the Jews; while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure Body; Thou didst rise on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. The powers of heaven therefore cried to Thee, O Giver of Life: Glory to Thy Resurrection O Christ! Glory to Thy Kingdom! Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou who lovest mankind.

Meeting of our Lord in the Temple (Tone 1)

Rejoice, O Virgin Theotokos, full of grace! From thee has shone the Sun of Righteousness, Christ our God, enlightening those who sat in darkness! Rejoice and be glad, O righteous elder; thou didst accept in thine arms the Redeemer of our souls, who grants us the Resurrection. *Glory...*

KONTAKIA

Publican and Pharisee (Tone 4)

Let us flee from the pride of the Pharisee and learn humility from the Publican's tears. Let us cry to our Savior: Have mercy on us, O only merciful One! *Now and ever...*
