TODAY'S HYMNS

TROPARIA

Resurrection (Tone 1)

When the stone had been sealed by the Jews; while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure Body; Thou didst rise on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. The powers of heaven therefore cried to Thee, O Giver of Life: Glory to Thy Resurrection O Christ! Glory to Thy Kingdom! Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou who lovest mankind.

St. Mary of Egypt (Tone 8)

The image of God was truly preserved in thee, O Mother, for thou didst take up the Cross and follow Christ. By so doing thou hast taught us to disregard the flesh for it passes away but to care instead for the soul, since it is immortal. Therefore thy spirit, O holy Mother Mary, rejoices with the angels.

KONTAKIA

Resurrection (Tone 1)

As God, Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory, raising the world with Thyself. Human nature praises Thee as God, for death has vanished. Adam exults O Master! Eve rejoices, for she is freed from bondage, and cries to Thee; Thou art the Giver of Resurrection to all, O Christ.

St. Mary of Egypt (Tone 3)

Having been a sinful woman, thou hast become through repentance a Bride of Christ. Having attained angelic life, thou didst defeat demons with the weapon of the Cross! Therefore, most glorious Mary, thou art a Bridge of the Kingdom. *Now and ever...*

Steadfast Protectress

Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us as we have set our hope on Thee.

St. Mary of Egypt (Tone 4)

God is wonderful in His saints, the God of Israel.

HYMN TO THE THEOTOKOS

Instead of "It Is Truly Meet...", we sing:

In Thee rejoices all creation, O Full of Grace; the assembly of angels and the race of men. O Sanctified Temple and spiritual Paradise, the glory of virgins from whom God was incarnate and became a child, our Eternal God. He made Thy body into a throne, and Thy womb He made more spacious than the heavens. In Thee rejoices all creation, O Full of Grace, glory to Thee!
