TODAY'S HYMNS

TROPARIA

Resurrection (Tone 2)

When Thou didst descend to death, O Life Immortal, Thou didst slay hell with the splendor of Thy Godhead! And when from the depths Thou didst raise the dead, all the powers of heaven cried out: O Giver of Life! Christ our God! Glory to Thee!

Pentecostarion (Tone 2)

The Noble Joseph, when he had taken down Thy most pure Body from the tree, wrapped it in fine linen and anointed it with spices, and placed it in a new tomb. But Thou didst rise on the third day, O Lord, granting the world great mercy.

Holy Apostle James (Tone 8)

Thou wast called to be a disciple and warrior of Christ, one of the exalted choir of Apostles. With thy brother John, thou didst abandon all to follow the Master, O James; thou wast filled with the Holy Spirit and didst proclaim Him to all. Thou didst bow thy head to the sword, the first of the twelve to shed thy blood! We celebrate thy memory, O blessed one! *Glory...*

KONTAKIA

Holy Apostle James (Tone 2)

O James, when thou didst hear the voice of the Word calling thee, thou didst abandon thy father's love and ran to Christ, together with thy brother John. With him thou wast accounted worthy to behold the divine Transfiguration of Christ.

Holy Myrrhbearing Women (Tone 2)

Thou didst command the myrrhbearers to rejoice, O Christ! By Thy Resurrection, Thou didst stop the lamentation of Eve, O God! Thou didst command them to preach to Thine apostles: The Savior is risen!

PROKEIMENA

Pentecostarion (Tone 6)

O Lord, save Thy people and bless Thine inheritance.

Holy Apostle James (Tone 8)

The righteous one shall rejoice in the Lord and shall set his hope on Him!

HYMN TO THE THEOTOKOS

Instead of "It Is Truly Meet..."

The Angel cried to the Lady, Full of Grace: "Rejoice, O Pure Virgin! Again I say: Rejoice! Your Son is risen from His three days in the tomb! With Himself He has raised all the dead!" Rejoice, O ye people! Shine! Shine! O New Jerusalem! The Glory of the Lord has shone on you! Exult now, and be glad, O Zion! Be radiant, O Pure Theotokos, in the Resurrection of your Son!
