TODAY'S HYMNS

TROPARIA

Resurrection (Tone 1)

When the stone had been sealed by the Jews; while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure Body; Thou didst rise on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. The powers of heaven therefore cried to Thee, O Giver of Life: Glory to Thy Resurrection O Christ! Glory to Thy Kingdom! Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou who lovest mankind.

Transfiguration of Our Lord (Tone 7)

Thou wast transfigured upon the mountain, O Christ our God, showing Thy glory to Thy disciples as far as they were able to bear it. At the intercessions of the Theotokos, make Thine everlasting light shine forth also upon us sinners. O giver of light, glory to Thee.

St. Tikhon of Zadonsk (Tone 8)

From thy youth thou didst love Christ, O blessed one. Thou hast been an example for all by word, life, love, faith, purity, and humility. Therefore, thou dost now abide in the heavenly mansions, where thou standest before the throne of the All-holy Trinity. Holy Hierarch Tikhon, pray for the salvation of our souls!

Transfiguration of Our Lord (Tone 7)

On the mountain Thou wast transfigured, and Thy disciples beheld Thy glory, O Christ our God, as far as they were able so to do: that when they saw Thee crucified, they might know that Thy suffering was voluntary, and might proclaim unto the world that Thou art truly the Brightness of the Father.

PROKEIMENA

Resurrection (Tone 4)

O Lord, how manifold are Thy works! In wisdom hast Thou made them all!

Resurrection (Tone 1)

My mouth shall speak wisdom. The meditation of my heart shall be understanding.

HYMN TO THE THEOTOKOS

Instead of "It is Truly Meet..."

Magnify, O my soul, the Lord who was transfigured on Mount Tabor! Thy childbearing was without corruption. God came forth from thy body clothed in flesh and appeared on earth and dwelt among men. Therefore, we all magnify thee, O Theotokos!
