Resurrection (Tone 3)

Saint Pimen (Tone 8)

By a flood of tears thou didst make the desert
fertile, and thy longing for God brought forth
fruits in abundance. By the radiance of miracles
thou didst illumine the whole universe. Our
Father Pimen, pray to Christ God to save our
souls!

Saint Liberius (Tone 1)

Let us who have betimes weakened amid
temptations and are assailed by the falsehoods
of this age, now make haste to the holy hierarchy
and confessor Liberius, and fall down, with
compunction crying aloud: O thou who didst
cleave unto the consubstantial Trinity, pray
fervently that we be saved.
