
TWELVE THINGS TO KNOW



TROPARIA

Resurrection (Tone 6)

The angelic powers were at Thy tomb; the guards became as dead men. Mary stood by Thy grave, seeking Thy most pure Body. Thou didst capture hell, not being tempted by it. Thou didst come to the Virgin, granting life. O Lord who didst rise from the dead: glory to Thee.

Elevation of the Cross (Tone 1)

O Lord, save Thy people, and bless Thine inheritance. Grant victories to the Orthodox Christians over their adversaries; and by virtue of Thy Cross preserve Thy habitation.

Martyrs (Tone 5)

You Blossomed in the courts of the Lord as a fruitful olive tree, holy martyr Sophia; in your contest you offered to Christ the sweet fruit of your womb, your daughters Faith, Hope and Love. Together with them intercede for us all.

KONTAKIA

Resurrection (Tone 6)

When Christ God the Giver of Life, raised all of the dead from the valleys of misery with His mighty hand, He bestowed resurrection on the human race. He is the Savior of all, the Resurrection, the Life and the God of all. Glory...

Elevation of the Cross (Tone 4)

PROKEIMENON

Extol the Lord our God; worship at His footstool, for it is holy!

HYMN TO THE THEOTOKOS

Instead of "It Is Truly Meet...," we sing:

Magnify, O my soul, the most precious Cross of the Lord Thou art a mystical Paradise O Theotokos, who, though untitled, hast brought forth Christ; Through Him the life-bearing wood of the Cross was planted on the earth. Now at its Exaltation as we bow in worship before it, we magnify thee.

COMMUNION HYMN

Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest!

The light of Thy countenance hast shone upon us, O Lord. Alleluia...
