


The service will last about 1.5 hours. Many people stand, but feel free to take a seat if needed. See 🕇 on page 2 for times when one should stand, if able.

TROPARIA

Resurrection (Tone 8)

Thou didst descend from on high O Merciful One! Thou didst accept the three day burial to free us from our sufferings! O Lord, our Life and Resurrection: glory to Thee!

St. Patrick (Tone 3)

Holy Bishop Patrick, faithful shepherd of Christ's royal flock, thou didst fill Ireland with the radiance of the Gospel: The mighty strength of the Trinity! Now that thou standest before the Savior, pray that He may preserve us in faith and love!

KONTAKIA

Resurrection (Tone 3)

By rising from the tomb, Thou didst raise the dead and resurrect Adam. Eve exults in Thy Resurrection, and the world celebrates Thy Rising from the dead, O greatly Merciful One! *Glory...*

St. Patrick (Tone 4)
