## MORTGAGE MATCH COMPLETE

A hearty "thank you" to the sponsors of our \$40,000 mortgage match program and to all of those who have contributed in any way toward paying off our parish mortgage. We are very pleased to announce that last month the full match was met and the sponsors have now begun honoring their portions of the match. When all is concluded, we will have in hand roughly \$200,000 of the \$305,000 we need to pay off the mortgage. We expect to apply all funds that we have to the principal of the mortgage in August, when our current interest rate lock and prepayment penalty expire. We're two-thirds of the way there, glory to God! Let's press on toward the ultimate finish line and begin to plan for the next phase of our parish's life!
