#### Prophet Joel (Tone 2)

We celebrate the memory of Thy Prophet Joel, O Lord. Through him, we beseech Thee: "Save our souls!"

### KONTAKIA

#### Resurrection (Tone 2)

Hell became afraid, O almighty Savior, seeing the miracle of Thy Resurrection from the tomb! The dead arose! Creation, with Adam, beheld this and rejoiced with Thee! And the world, O my Savior, praises Thee forever.

#### Fathers (Tone 2)

Illumined by the Spirit, thy heart was a vessel of illustrious prophecy, seeing far-off things as though they were present. Therefore we venerate thee, glorious prophet Joel.

## LITURGY OF ST JAMES

On the Sunday closest to the feast of St. James (October 23), we have been blessed by His Eminence to celebrate the ancient "Liturgy of St. James" in place of the Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom. The Liturgy of St. James was the typical parish liturgy of Jerusalem, Palestine, Mount Sinai, Georgia, and parts of the Levant from the 4th century until the time of the Crusades and was prayed almost daily by great saints of the Church such as Cyril of Jerusalem, Sabbas the Sanctified, and John Climacus. Through their prayers may God bless this occasion for the upbuilding of His holy Church.
