TROPARION

Resurrection (Tone 5)

Let us, the faithful, praise and worship the Word, co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit, born for our salvation from the Virgin; for He willed to be lifted up on the Cross in the flesh, to endure death, and to raise the dead by His glorious Resurrection.

St. Nektarios (Tone 1)

O faithful, let us honor Nektarios the divine servant of Christ, offspring of Silyvria and guardian of Aegina, who appeared as a true friend of virtue, pouring forth all manner of healing upon those who reverently cry: Glory to Him who gave thee strength! Glory to Him who granted thee a crown! Glory to Him who through thee grants healing to all!

KONTAKIA

Resurrection (Tone 5)

Thou didst descend into hell, O my Savior, shattering its gates as Almighty; resurrecting the dead as Creator, and destroying the sting of death, Thou hast delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of man, and we all cry out to Thee: O Lord, save us!

St.Nektarios (Tone 2)

Let us sing praises with gladness of heart to the newly-shining star of Orthodoxy, the newly-built rampart of the Church. Being glorified by the power of the Spirit, he pours forth the abundant grace of healings upon those who cry: "Rejoice, Father Nektarios."
