TROPARION

Pentecostarion (Tone 7)

From the sealed tomb, Thou didst shine forth, O Life! Through closed doors Thou didst come to Thy Disciples, O Christ God. Renew in us through them an upright spirit, by the greatness of Thy mercy, O Resurrection of all.

Glory... Now and ever...

KONTAKIA

Pentecostarion (Tone 1)

Thomas touched Thy life-giving side with an eager hand, O Christ God, when Thou camest to Thine Apostles through closed doors. He cried out with all: "Thou art my Lord and my God!"

PROKEIMENON

Pentecostarion (Tone 1)

Great is our Lord and abundant in power; His understanding is beyond measure.

HYMN TO THE THEOTOKOS

Instead of "It is truly meet..., " we sing:

The angel cried to the Lady, full of grace: "Rejoice, rejoice, O pure Virgin! Again, I say: Rejoice, your Son is risen from His three days in the tomb! With Himself He has raised all the dead." Rejoice, rejoice, O ye people! Shine, shine! Shine, O new Jerusalem! The glory of the Lord has shone on you. Exult now, exult, and be glad, O Zion! Be radiant, O pure Theotokos, in the Resurrection, the Resurrection of your Son!

COMMUNION HYMN

Praise the Lord, O Jerusalem! Praise thy God, O Zion!
Alleluia...
