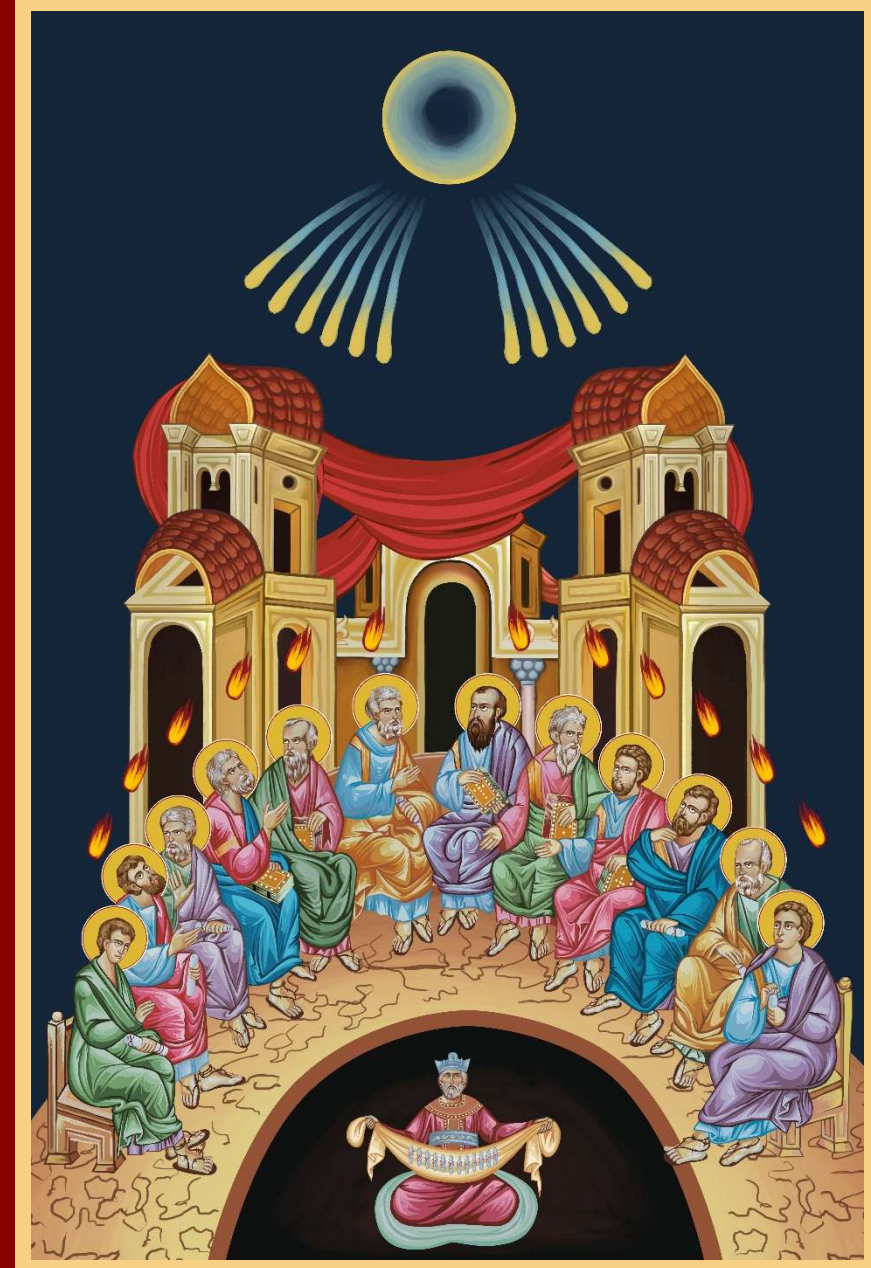

ANTIPHONS

First Antiphon (Psalm 18)

The heavens are telling the glory of God; and the firmament proclaims His handiwork.

Refrain: Through the prayers of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

Day to day pours forth speech, and night to night declares knowledge. *Refrain*

Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. *Refrain*

Glory... Now and ever... *Refrain*

Second Antiphon (Psalm 19)

The Lord answer you in the day of trouble! The name of the God of Jacob protect you!

Refrain: O Good Comforter, save us who sing to Thee: Alleluia!

May He send you help from the sanctuary, and give you support from Zion. *Refrain*

May He grant you your heart's desire, and fulfill all your plans. *Refrain*

Third Antiphon & Troparion

In Thy strength the king rejoices, O Lord, and exults greatly in Thy salvation.

Troparion (Tone 8)

Blessed art Thou, O Christ our God, Who hast revealed the fishermen as most wise by sending down upon them the Holy Spirit; through them Thou didst draw the world into Thy net. O Lover of Man, glory to Thee!

ANTIPHONS (continued)

Thou hast given him his heart's desire, and hast not withheld the request of his lips. *Troparion*

For Thou dost meet him with goodly blessings; Thou dost set a crown of fine gold upon his head.

Troparion

Introit: Be Thou exalted, O Lord, in thy strength! We will sing and praise Thy power! *Troparion*

KONTAKION

Pentecost (Tone 8)

When the Most High came down and confused the tongues, He divided the nations; but when He distributed the tongues of fire, He called all to unity. Therefore, with one voice we glorify the all-holy Spirit!

HYMN OF VENERATION

Instead of "Holy God...", we sing:

As many as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. Alleluia.

PROKEIMENON

Pentecost (Tone 8)

Their proclamation has gone out into all the earth, and their words to the ends of the universe.
