TROPARION

Resurrection (Tone 5)

Let us, the faithful, praise and worship the Word, co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit, born for our salvation from the Virgin; for He willed to be lifted up on the Cross in the flesh, to endure death, and to raise the dead by His glorious Resurrection.

Ven. Paisios (Tone 1)

O ye faithful, let us honor Paΐsios, the offspring of Phárasa, the glory of Athos, emulator of the Holy Ascetics of old, and equal to them in honor; O grace-filled vessel, who hastens speedily to the pious faithful who cry out: "Glory to Him Who gave thee strength! Glory to Him Who granted thee a crown! Glory to Him Who, through thee, grants healing to all!"

KONTAKION

Resurrection (Tone 5)

Thou didst descend into hell, O my Savior, shattering its gates as Almighty; resurrecting the dead as Creator, and destroying the sting of death, Thou hast delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of man, and we all cry out to Thee: O Lord, save us!

Glory...

Ven. Paisios (Tone 8)

Let us praise the most renowned ascetic of the Holy Mountain, and the newly-shining luminary of the Church; let us praise him with hymns with all our heart, for he guides the faithful toward a life of excellence, filling them with rivers of gifts; therefore we cry out: "Rejoice, Father Paΐsios."

Ven. Paisios (Tone 7)

Let the saints be exalted in glory; let them sing for joy on their couches.

COMMUNION HYMN
